Rural Enterprise Assistance and Coaching Hostel (REACH) PROJECT STATUS

The Rural Enterprise Assistance and Coaching Hostel (REACH) Project was launched in Camrose in May 2015, and will continue for a year, working with entrepreneurs, ensuring that they have a strong foundation to establish and grow their businesses. The program benefits a number of emerging rural Alberta business startups by interpreting their unique business development needs and developing service solutions that supports their needs. These services are offered by a team of appropriately skilled business professionals, using state of the art communications technologies that from time-to-time will be augmented through "in-person" sessions. These services are not intended to be judgmental, rather focusing on nurturing the entrepreneurs participating in the pilot - thus the use of the term "hostel" in defining the pilot.

The Program

There are six elements to this program, that are offered throughout the year:

- 1. Taking the Plunge Introductory Roundtable
- 2. Basic Elements Three-day long course on the basic elements of business
- 3. Formalizing Business Plans
- 4. Business Plan Presentations
- 5. Coach Support one-on-one support with coach and experts addressing various topics and issues impacting their enterprises
- 6. Maintaining the relationships various activities, workshops, meetings, round tables, etc.

The Priorities

1. Decrease the number of new business start-up closures;

Increase and enhance entrepreneurship training and knowledge in rural Alberta;

- 2. Collaborate with stakeholders (such as CF, RABC, GOA etc.) to provide a well-rounded set of resources for new entrepreneurs in rural Alberta;
- 3. Provide a forum for learning and networking for new entrepreneurs;
- 4. Provide long-term support to new businesses;
- 5. Use this pilot to create a business case and expand this program further into the BRAED Region, and all rural areas in Alberta;
- 6. Align with local and Provincial programming.

Success to Date

- 11 individuals began the program
- 8 decided to continue through the whole program

- Several clients have opened their shops and are running their business with the guidance of our mentors
- Our financial partners and in kind support continues to support the program
- There are talks of expanding the program to provide a second offering in Camrose, as well as expanding to other communities in the BRAED Region
